STAGE TWO: Application evaluation

Your transcripts will be sent to our transcript evaluator for review and grade point average (GPA) calculation, at no cost to you. Evaluations will take a minimum of 5-7 days. In your admissions portal you will see *OIPD Transcript Evaluation*. This requirement will remain blank until the transcript evaluation has been completed. You do not need to submit any additional documents while the evaluation is being completed. Once our office receives your report, it will be uploaded into your admissions portal.

STAGE THREE: Scholarship evaluation

Admissions decision will be made and academic merit scholarships will be awarded based on GPA. Other scholarships will be awarded if eligible.

STAGE FOUR: Accept your offer

- 1. Student logs into <u>admissions portal</u> to formally accept admissions offer.
 - a. At the bottom of your portal, you will see the 'International Admissions Reply Form', click those words

- 2. Student pays \$200 enrollment deposit via Flywire
 - a. You will see a new section on your portal, saying there is a payment due. Click the 'Submit Payment for 200.00 USD' words



b. You will be taken to the Flywire website where you will complete payment

STAGE FIVE: Visa process

- 1. Saint Martin's sends Declaration of Finances document. Student completes document and returns it along with bank statements showing enough funds to pay for education.
 - 2. Saint Martin's issues the I-20 document.
 - a. Students should carefully read this document and confirm their personal information is correct.
 - 3. Student <u>pays i-901 fee</u> and makes visa appointment with <u>local US Embassy/Consulate</u>. Students should bring with them to the visa interview hard copies of their:
 - a. Form I-20 for Saint Martin's University
 - b. Valid passport
 - c. Financial documents
 - d. Letter of admission from school
 - e. SEVIS I-901 fee receipt
 - f. Scholarship offer letter (if applicable)
 - g. Any other supporting documents

STAGE SIX: Last steps to before arrival

Once visa received, log into <u>admissions portal</u> and complete the following documents:

- h. Housing application
- i. Upload immunization records
- j. SMU email account set-up
- k. Complete airport pick up form
